About the theme

The advent of Partition, be it India-Pakistan, East-West Bengal or Northern-Southern Ireland, brings about an event in history that recalls itself in contemporary times. Living through the social and personal memory of the people the arbitrary borders of the nation-state stand as a grave reminder of the event itself. Stemming from disciplines like Memory studies and Trauma studies the question of Partition becomes a much-investigated field, especially in the Indian context. The field requires an interdisciplinary approach and sensitive attention to Partition related details. To look forward to a better future regarding the sanctioning of human rights, the theme of Partition enquires about the past that influences countries with post-Partition dilemmas. It situates and gives voice to the human miseries wrought upon by the Partition becoming the “other” of Independence as Sukeshi Kamra called it.

Within this event stands a convoluted past that demands to be researched and enquired. Thus, this issue of the magazine will be dealing with the past to understand and aid in the research of future posterity.

What kinds of entries are published?

Authors can submit entries under the following categories:

1. Short Articles (Maximum 2500 words)
2. Photo essays (1000-1500 words)
3. Memoirs/ Stories/ Translations (1000-1500 words)
4. Poetries (About 500 words)

Editorial Charges

Single authors – Rs. 1500/-

Multiple authors – Rs. 2000/-

The entries must be the original work of the contributors. Originality is examined by the reviewers based on ideas presented, arguments and methodology adopted.

Similarity up to 15% will be allowed. Any entry which is above the suggested similarity threshold will be rejected by the reviewers.
